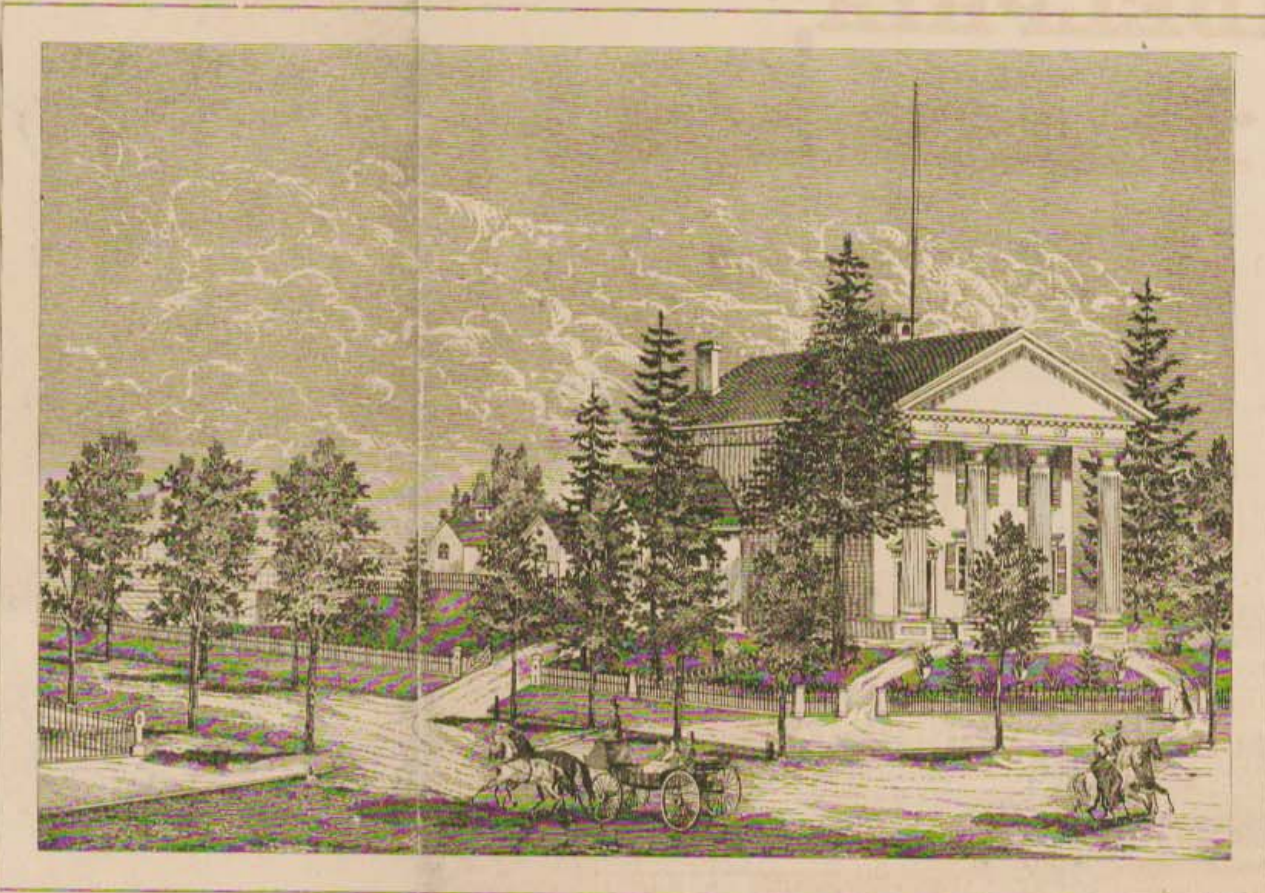
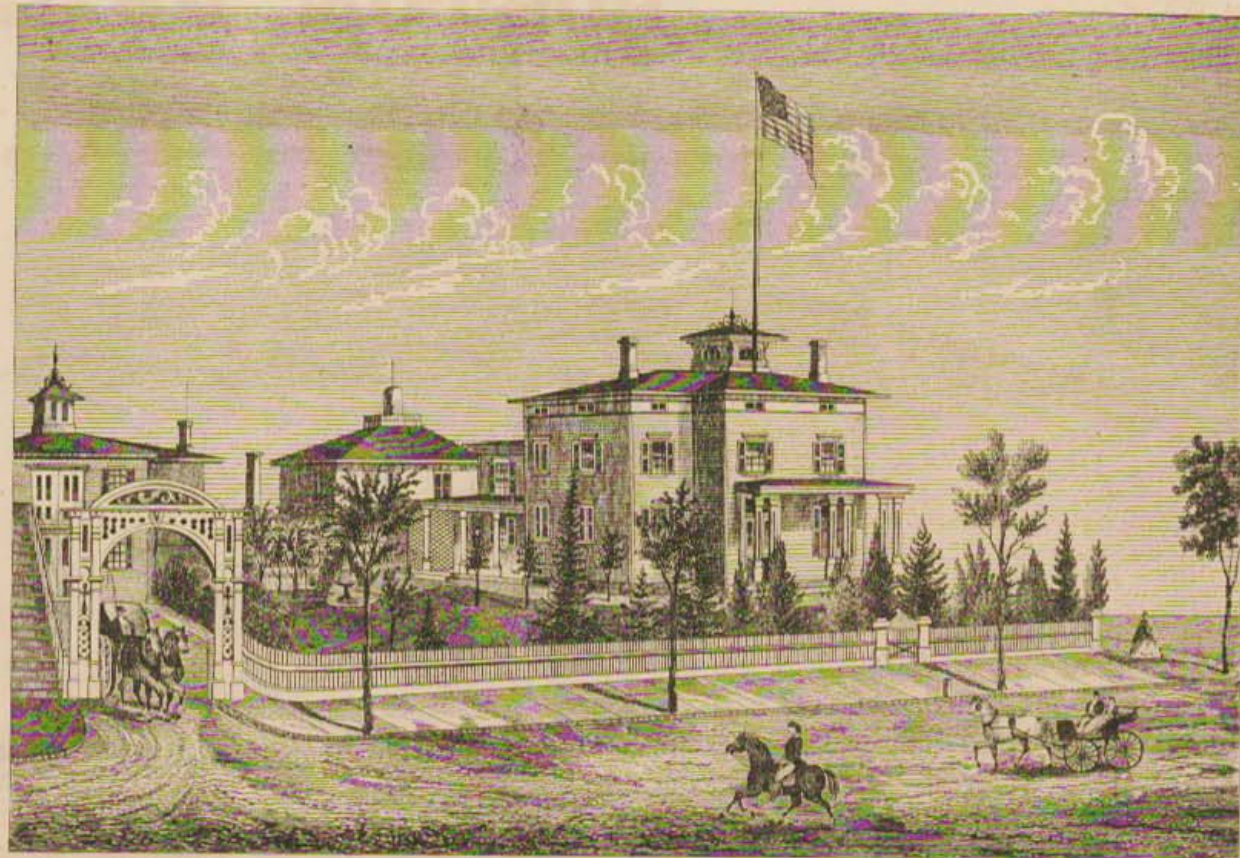




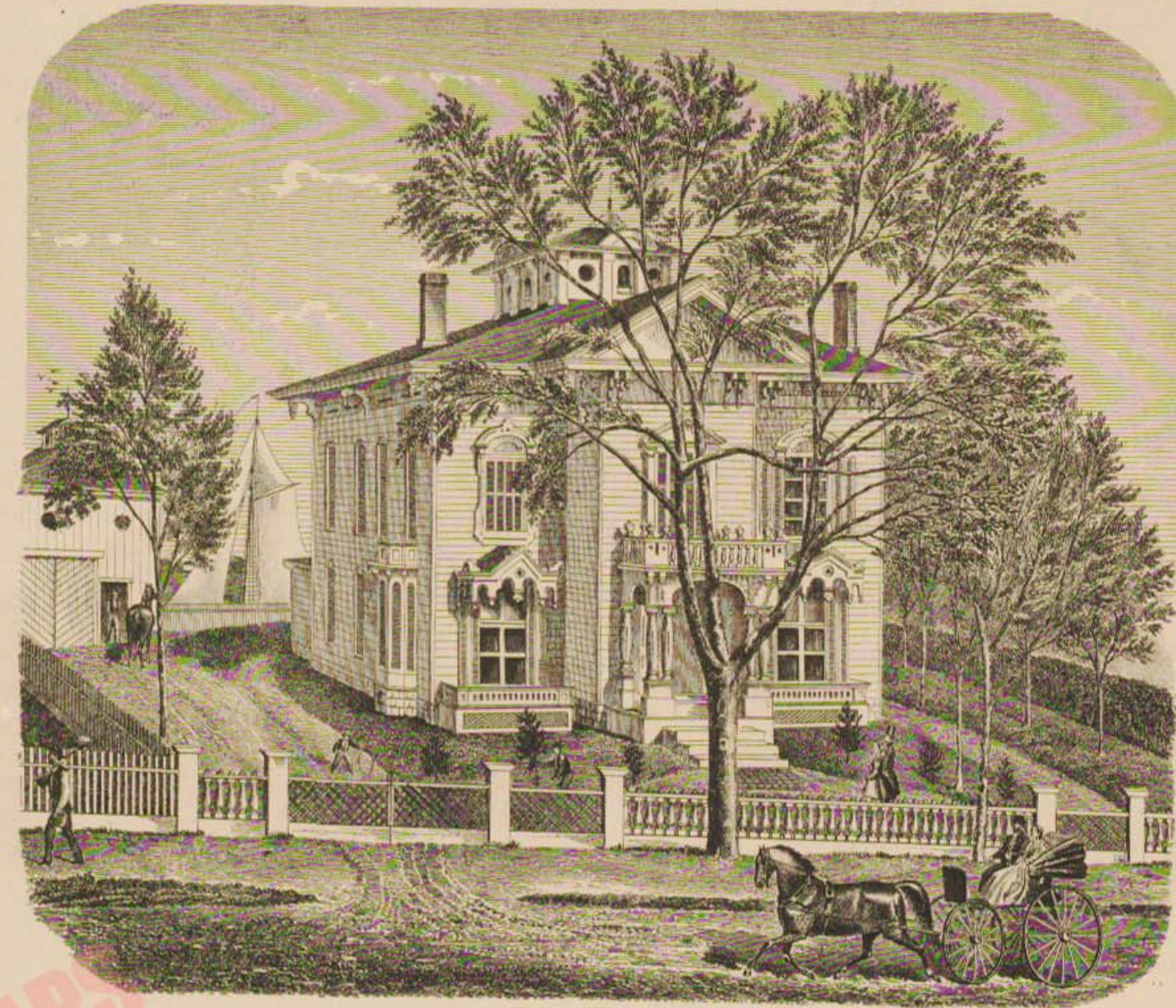
SUMMER RESIDENCE OF JOHN H. KEYSER KEYSER ISLAND NEAR NORWALK, CONN.



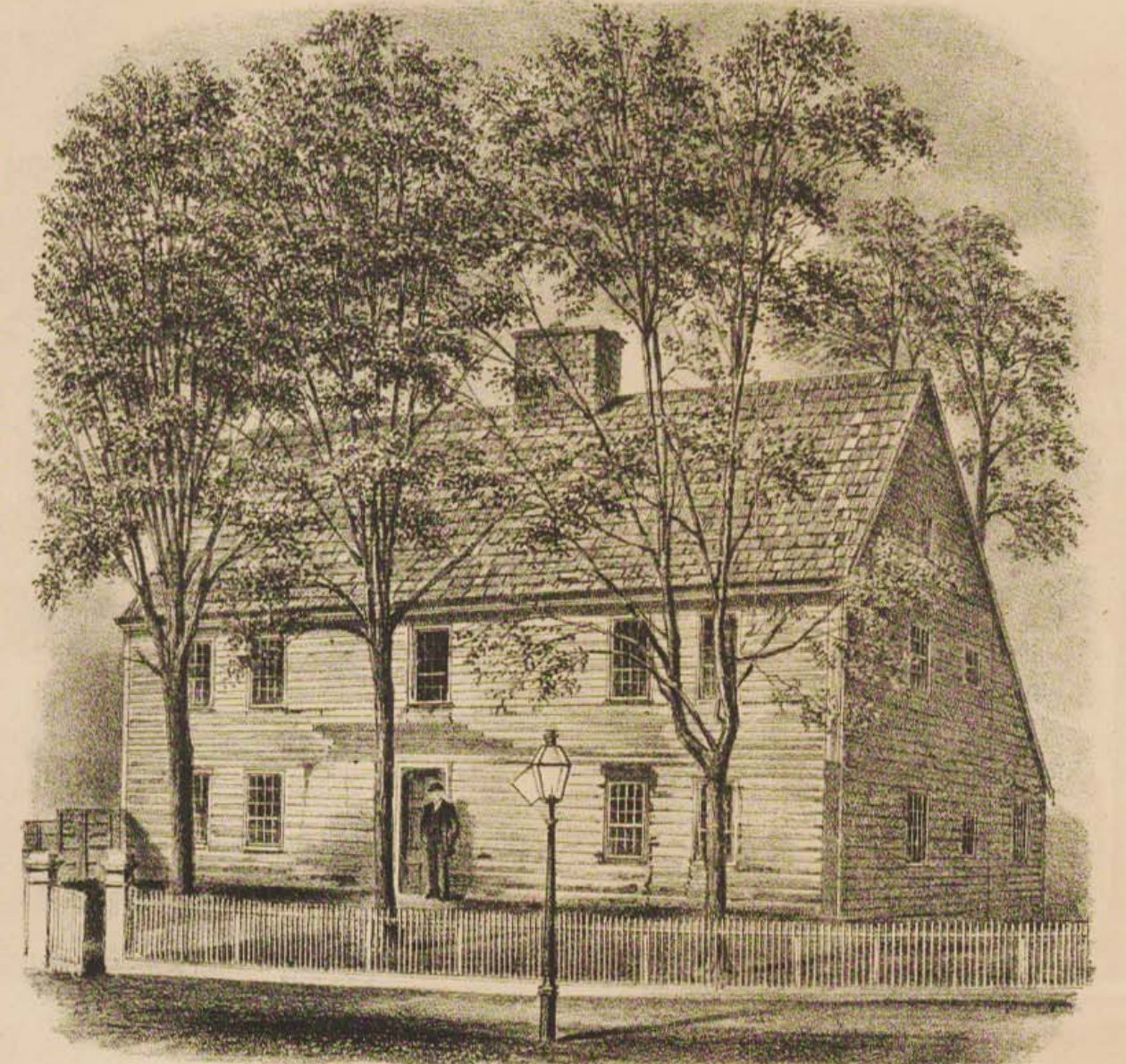

It was kept as a Hotel by Captain David Webb, and built long before the Revolution, and was one of the first houses erected in Stamford.
